

History

In 1995 a group of concerned parents and business leaders found the need to establish a new school for children with autism in Jacksonville Florida. The Jericho School was created to make available the best practices in early childhood development and education to families who have children with developmental disabilities. At that time, The Jericho School was one of only a few select schools in the United States to provide a science-based curriculum utilizing Applied Behavior Analysis. Jericho has become a model program and a leader in the treatment of children with autism and the application of Applied Behavior Analysis and Verbal Behavior.

Mission

The mission of The Jericho School (non profit 501(c) 3 corporation) is to provide comprehensive, individualized sciencebased education not otherwise available based in our community. We believe those children with autism and other developmental delays deserve the opportunity to reach their full potential. The school's curriculum provides effective treatment and education programs to children and their families based on Applied Behavior Analysis and Verbal Behavior.

The Science of Learning *and the* The Art of Teaching

The Jericho School is a private, non-profit school in Jacksonville, Florida for children with autism and other developmental disabilities. The Jericho School provides comprehensive, individualized instruction that is based on the science of Applied Behavior Analysis and B.F. Skinner's analysis of Verbal Behavior.

Many decades of research documents the effectiveness of Applied Behavior Analysis in reducing inappropriate behavior and increasing communication and appropriate social behavior. The United States Surgeon General has endorsed intensive behavior intervention as the most effective treatment for individuals with autism and other developmental delays. Although we specialize in the acquisition of language and communication skills, we also provide instruction for a great deal of academic, pre-academic, independent functioning and socialization skills areas.

The Jericho School is the longest serving school for children with autism in the state of Florida utilizing Applied Behavior Analysis and Verbal Behavior. The Jericho School has a 5 out of 5 star rating according to greatschools.org. As a non-profit organization The Jericho School is dedicated to providing a high quality of services and we are committed to Progress over Profits.

Individual and Classroom

The Jericho School offers a variety of Individual and Classroom Educational Programs that are designed to provide the appropriate level of instruction for each student. A comprehensive Individual Student Plan is developed to identify specific goals and objectives. Classrooms are provided for 1:1, 2:1 and 3:1 student to teacher ratios in efforts to maximize individualized attention, small group and socialization opportunities for each student depending on the level of their need.

Communication Clinic

The Clinic is for those students and families who wish to access the same ABA therapy for one or two days per week for specific scheduled hours per day. The Clinic provides instruction on a one-to-one basis with each clinic student working with a trained experienced clinic therapist. The Clinic allows us to focus on specific needs for the student during the clinic hours. Although the Clinic is primarily utilized for intensive language intervention, this time can be used to address a wide variety of skill deficit areas.

Outreach Program

The Outreach Program allows The Jericho School to provide parents access to FREE training and education. The program increases parents' and other service providers' knowledge, skills and abilities in working with children with autism; teaching specific skills, reducing inappropriate behaviors and developing language skills. Education is provided on the basic principles of Applied Behavior Analysis and how to use B.F. Skinner's analysis of Verbal Behavior to teach language to children with autism and other developmental disabilities.

ABA Kindergarten Program

The ABA Kindergarten Program has a low student to teacher ratio (2:1) to maximize individualized instruction, small group and socialization opportunities. A focus of the classroom is on intensive language intervention as well as academic skills, basic learner skills, independent functioning skills and social skills. The classroom implements a science based curriculum incorporating ABA and Verbal Behavior.



Intensive Summer Program

The Jericho School Intensive Summer Program is four weeks of intensive Applied Behavior Analysis and Verbal Behavior services for children with developmental disabilities. Each child will receive an Individualized Program with identified goals and objectives for acquisition of targeted skills. You can choose a two week program or take advantage of all four weeks for the Intensive Individualized Summer Program.
